For each other's ideas and contributions.

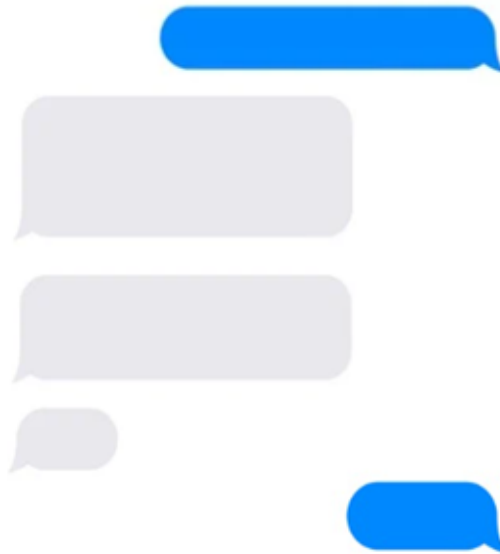
Communicate
